Prerequisite

- Randolph County Citizens only - Citizens should be prepared to show ID if asked
- Maximum of ten 60 gallon bags or cans
- Maximum of two bulky items that are too large for a 60 gallon bag
- Limit one trip per day per resident

Note: For household waste that exceeds these limits, citizens may also bring material to the [Great Oak Landfill](#) operated by Waste Management. 1 ton minimum (Estimated \$41.08 plus tax and environmental cost - Approximately \$50.00).

Limits

- Antifreeze and Motor Oil - Limit 5 gallons per person per day
- Tires (must be off rim) - Limit 5
 - The Solid Waste Facility accepts more than 5 tires with a properly executed NC Scrap Tire Certification - form is available at the Scalehouse
